


Supply of Written Scheme of Examination and Thorough Examination

Written Scheme of Examination

Our fully qualified Engineers will visit site and carry out a survey of the equipment to be covered under PSSR 2000. Once this information is collated by the Competent Person we will provide a Written Scheme of Examination (WSE) for each pressure system. The WSE is provided **Free of Charge** subject to IATT undertaking the Thorough Examinations.

Thorough Examination

We will carry out a Thorough Examination in accordance with the provided WSE and issue a report of our findings. The WSE requires the duty holder to have the items identified on the written scheme examined annually, which IATT can carry out for the same cost each year.

Obviously this price may rise slightly, but only due to inflation cost.

Documentation

Any documentation relating to the pressure system should be made available/kept on file for inspection by our engineer if required. For example, Certificates of Conformity for Pressure Vessels; these need to be retained by the User / Owner and our system can be used to collate this data.

Inspection/Examination and Review of Written Schemes of Examination

This scope of work is for the inspection/examination of the equipment covered under the WSE.

Our engineer will visit site and remove, inspect and test items. The inspection includes the entire system, the protective devices and associated pipework (if required under the WSE).

The vessels are opened by our engineer (exception steam/mixed gas) for the Thorough Examination at the period stated in the WSE. Depending on vessel type.

Working Examinations are carried out on a 12 monthly basis.

The WSE requires to be reviewed with any item addition or removal, also periodically as seen fit by the competent person.

The price is inclusive of on-site testing of protective devices (safety valves, gauges and other items which may be identified in the WSE).

The report produced will validate that the items have been examined in accordance with "Pressure Systems Safety Regulations 2000 (PSSR)". These reports may be required by the Health and Safety Executive / or your insurers to provide evidence that examinations have taken place.

Our engineers have vast experience of pressure systems and therefore can offer independent advice.

Pressure gauges, pressure relief valves and other safety accessories need to be removed to allow connection to our test equipment. Our Examiner will be prepared to do this work, but where special equipment is required, or an item is difficult to remove, it will be the responsibility of the customer to provide alternative methods for the inspection to be carried out.

If assistance is not available to facilitate these tests, IATT are not liable for any damage caused. If the test cannot be completed, the Inspector may deem the equipment unsafe to operate.
